## **EASIER:**

Uses Do-re-mi (and starts on Mi)

Hot Cross buns

Mary Had a Little Lamb

## **HARDER:**

Use all five notes:
Jingle Bells (starts Mi)
Ode to Joy (starts on Mi)

Use all five notes, and JUMPS to five below:

Alouette (starts on Do)

Old MacDonald (starts on Do)

Uses all five notes, PLUS the sixth note La

Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

These can be played using ONLY black keys:

Amazing Grace (starts on Sol)

Old MacDonald (starts on Do, and jumps down to Sol)

Hot Cross Buns/Mary Had a Little Lamb (both start on Mi)
