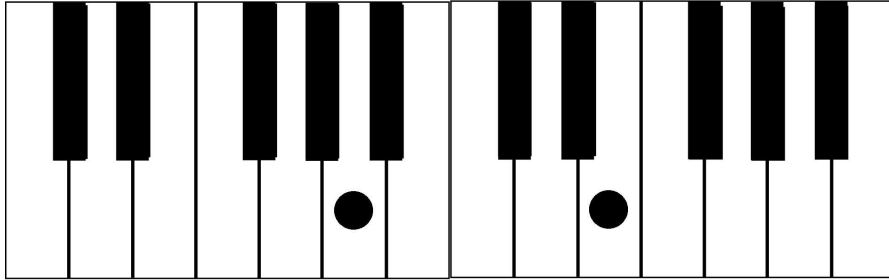


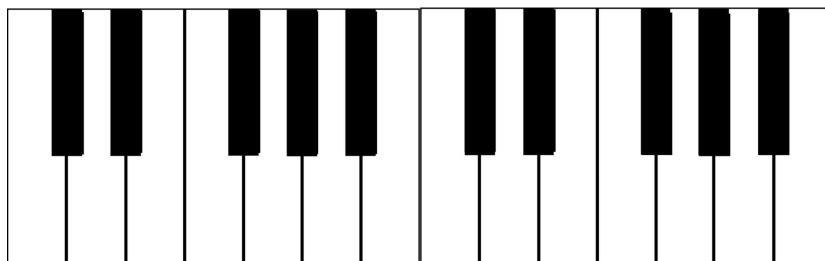
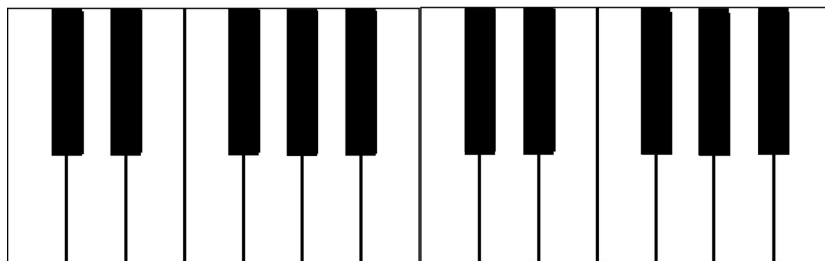
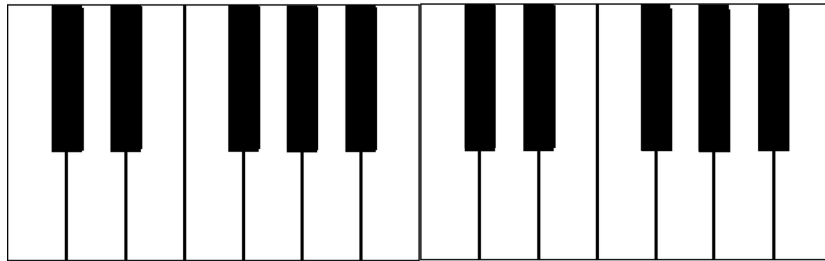
Fifths

Here is a ***fifth*** on the piano, using A as the low note. Find it on your piano, and play with a comfortable hand.



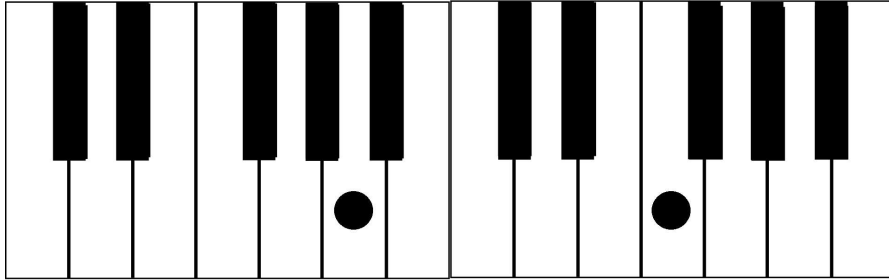
Pick a different white note on each of the keyboards below, and mark a ***fifth*** above. Play all over the piano with a comfortable hand.

Most of these fifths sound nice, but there's one white note that sounds VERY strange played with a fifth above. Can you find it?



Sixths

Here is a **sixth** on the piano, using A as the low note. Find it on your piano, and play with a comfortable hand. Notice the “extra” note between your thumb and pointer.



Pick a different white note on each of the keyboards below, and mark a **sixth** above. Play all over the piano with a comfortable hand.

Listen to the sound of the sixths. Are there any that sound dissonant? How do you like the sound compared to fifths?
